Plant Expansion

Dear Mr. Elgar

After reading the local news papers and listening and talking to many residents of Glen Abbey I would like to express very strongly that I have not found even one person who would approve the planned expansion. The major concerns of the residents are raised in the article of Jennifer Lobo in "Oakville Today" of Thursday February 06, 2003 on page 2 and many letters to the editor on page 13. Although some useful information is provided in the other letter to the editor by Mr. Patric Murphy of the Halton Region, I still consider that sufficient work has not been done to address all the environmental concerns especially the real potential of increased odour levels and pollutants in our air with the planned expansion.

The Region should consider whether it is prudent to significantly expand such a facility in the middle of a residential neighbourhood. It is the living besides the Plant which concerns the residents and public acceptance is a must. Alternatives must be considered and answers to environmental issues must be provided to the satisfaction of the residents. For an important issue such as this for the public the scheme should not be rushed and more time should be given to the public to comment and participate adequately. In the meantime the public should be provided with data which people can understand, digest and comment.
